Subjects conducted in the semester I introduce issues of sustainable development from the environmental, economic and socio-legal perspective.

In the semester II, students become acquainted with the planning and management processes as well as the use of raw materials and economic analysis in the implementation of sustainable development goals, both in cities and in rural areas. Students have the opportunity to choose classes according to their interests.

Semester III offers an overview of the best practices and tools currently used to support sustainable development processes. Most of the classes this semester have the character of practical projects with the participation of practitioners and experts from outside the University of Warsaw.

Semester IV is devoted to writing a diploma project and this is also supported by a research study in organizations or institutions chosen by students according to their interest.

By addressing sustainability challenges and finding suitable solutions, students will obtain knowledge, competences and skills that will enable them to lead the interdisciplinary teams developing the local, regional, sectoral and institutional policies and strategies on sustainable development.
