USOS

USOS - University Studies Service System. It's an IT system supporting the functioning of the University. It contains, among others, data of University employees and students as well as information about subjects and fields of study.

For students, USOS is primarily a tool where you can:

- see your schedule,
- grades,
- submit an application
- register for classes





The most important for a student in USOS is the tab. :

"STUDENT' S SECTION", Here you can find:

- Access to grades
- Registration for obligatory subjects,
- Passing stages,
- · Linking subjects to the program and stage of studies

"DIRECTORY", here you can find:

- · Names of lecturers and view of their timetables,
- Contact e-mail
- Courses

"COMON SECTION", here you can:

- Submit applications for:
 - scholarships,
 - places in student dormitories
- Find "workouts" that will be needed at the end of studies

Rejestracja/Registration It is here that enrollment for obligatory classes takes place

Examples of applications that can be submitted through the USOS system:

- Application for conditional completion of a stage
- Application for repeating a stage of study NOTE! After submitting an application please inform administration (Katarzyna Soładaczuk, that you did it. There is no automatic notification)

Courses linkages in the USOS system

At the end of each semester you should remember about the courses linkages, i.e. assigning subjects to the program and stage of studies **For example**: if in the field of Sustainable Development, the subject of "Climate Change" is in the program of the 1 year, we link "Climate change" to the **Sustainable Development program** and to the **SD-11** stage (first "1" stands for the first year and second "1" stands for first semester)

Obligatory training on security and health safety standards (BHP)

- BHP training concerns the security, health safety and fire protection.
- It is compulsory for students entering the first year of first-cycle, second-cycle, full-time and part-time studies.
- The training is conducted in the form of e-learning it should be completed throughout the study period
- Teaching materials are available
- Passing the test is a condition for completing the course

ECTS - points

ECTS credit points (European Credit Transfer System)

- By completing a course, seminar, or module, you get awarded ECTS-credit points.
- Every ECTS credit point represents the amount of workload you accomplished in that period of time.
- The amount of work required throughout the academic year corresponds to 60 ECTS credits; an average of 30 credits per semester.

ECTS credits assigned per degree type:

One year of studies, usually applies to graduate certificates - 60 ECTS-credits

A 3-year Bachelor's programme - 180 ECTS-credits

A 2-year Master's programme - 120 ECTS-credits

Tokens

- Token registration is based on the fact that we get a pool of 300 tokens for elective classes.
- If you use tokens to register for classes, but do not succeed to pass them, you loose them
- token registration takes place via the UL system (which is part of the USOS system)

Each Student initially receives 300 tokens for the entire duration of the studies

Oath

From the academic year 2020/2021 at the University of Warsaw is available

oath in electronic form

- The submission of the Oath must be confirmed in the USOSweb system within one month from the start of the semester, in each program where the admitted person intends to study.
- The rejection of the oath is treated as an information that the person admitted to studies has not confirmed the oath in the USOSweb system.
- When the person admitted to studies did not confirm the oath in the USOS system one month from the start of the semester results in a failure to start the studies

Student ID cards

- Mobile Student's ID card is an electronic version of this document having the same legal value as the printed ID. Only those who have a PESEL number assigned by the Polish authorities (not by University) can apply for it.
- To download it, first install the "Mobilny USOS" and "mObywatel" applications on your smartphone.
- Students for who got the information that their students ID cards have been printed may apply for mID, without picking up the printed ID.
- The printed ID's are to be picked up at the Sectretariate for Students Affairs room no. 2005




