

Information on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR/RODO):

1. The administrator of the personal data of the candidate and the scholarship holder is the University of Warsaw represented by the Rector with its registered office at [Krakowskie Przedmieście 26/28](#), 00-927 Warsaw. The administrator can be contacted by selecting one of the contact forms located on the website: <https://www.uw.edu.pl/kontakt/>.
2. The Administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer to supervise the correctness of personal data processing, who can be contacted via e-mail address: iod@adm.uw.edu.pl.
3. The personal data of candidates and scholarship holders will be processed for the purpose of participation in the Erasmus+ programme.
4. The basis for the processing of the candidate's personal data is the consent to the processing of personal data. The data of the qualified scholarship holders will be processed on the basis of the agreement concluded by the University of Warsaw with the Foundation for the Development of the Education System – National Agency (NA) and Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing "Erasmus+": the EU programme for education, training, youth and sport and repealing Decisions No. 1719/2006/EC, 1720/2006/EC and 1298/2008/EC.
5. Providing data by the candidate for the scholarship is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the selection procedure. Providing data by qualified scholarship holders is obligatory, if they are not provided, the scholarship will not be able to be paid.
6. The recipients of the data will be entities authorized under the law and the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (FRSE - the operator of the Erasmus+ program), a foreign university or a host organization to which the student/graduate has been qualified for part-time studies abroad.
7. The data will be stored for a period of 5 years from the receipt of the letter from FRSE closing the settlement of the project, i.e. no later than 31.12.2028.
8. The scholarship holder has the right to access the content of his/her data and the right to rectify them and limit processing. The candidate has the right to withdraw his/her consent at any time. Information about the withdrawal of consent should be sent to erasmusbwz@uw.edu.pl.
9. A candidate has the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if he/she considers that the processing of his/her personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.
